



Windermere Foundation Application for Funds

The Windermere Foundation is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization created by Windermere Real Estate for the purpose of raising and distributing funds to support low-income and homeless assistance programs for families throughout the West.

For our purposes, "family" is defined as a parent(s) or legal guardian with one or more children under the age of 18. All funds must be distributed through an eligible nonprofit organization and readily tracked back to the families and children being served. Public schools, colleges and vocational schools may also apply for funds. Sponsorships and administrative expenses are not eligible for Windermere Foundation funds.

Social Service organizations that assist low-income and homeless families may apply for a grant through a local Windermere office. Applications may be directed to the Foundation Representative for funding consideration (please contact the office for the name of their current Foundation Representative).
